Dear Prospective Student:

This letter is to inform you of the eligibility requirements to receive the Duval/Nassau County Chapter Financial Assistance \$1000 Scholarship. *Applications must be postmarked by June 30, 2019, as late applications will not be reviewed.*

Applicants who desire to attend Bethune-Cookman University must provide the following documents to confirm:

- Must be a 2019 High School Graduating Senior.
- Must reside in Duval or Nassau County.
- Must have taken either the SAT or ACT with a score of at least 1100/17 respectively.
- Must have achieved a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must submit a copy of the Letter of Acceptance from Bethune-Cookman University.
- Must submit a copy of the FAFSA (Financial Aid Application for Student Assistance) letter of determination based on need.
- Must submit a letter from an organization verifying community/volunteer service.
- Must submit unopened letter with the copy of your official transcript with school seal.
- Must submit two (2) letters of recommendations from either of the following: teacher, pastor, high school principal, counselor, B-CU alumnus, community leader or your employer.
- Must submit a 2 page essay (12 pt. font) on one of the following topics:
 - "Why Is Accomplishing A College Education Important to You?"
 - "Why Is Bethune-Cookman University Your Educational Choice?"
