- Students must take SLS 1103 within the first two semesters of participation in dual enrollment.

- 9. STA 2023 (Elementary Statistics)
 - a. Prerequisite: completion of MGF 2106 (Finite Math) or MAC 1105 (College Algebra) course with "C" or higher
- 10. MAC 1114 (Trigonometry)
 - a. Prerequisite: completion of MAC 1105 (College Algebra) course with "C" or higher
